Duties:

If selected as an IDP intern, you will provide administrative support to state party staff and gain valuable skills and first-hand insight into the inner workings of the political process. Responsibilities may include:

- campaign research
- voter outreach
- data entry
- assistance with and visits to local campaign events
- special projects

Qualifications:

The IDP is seeking highly motivated, self-starting students who are passionate about Democratic politics. Candidates must:

- be trustworthy and responsible
- communicate effectively with others
- have the ability to navigate and prioritize competing responsibilities
- be flexible and willing to help where needed

Start/end dates: dates are flexible, depending on your school's schedule

Length/availability: 6 weeks minimum

Hours:

- summer internships entail a minimum commitment of 30 hours/week
- school- year positions require at least 12 hours/week

Deadline: Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
